Through intentional stewardship and a commitment to faith development, safety, and family, The Campground will remain a sacred refuge where lives are renewed and communities are equipped to **share God's love for generations to come**.



A Sacred Space

For more than 175 years, these sacred grounds have offered sanctuary, renewal, and a place of encounter—where children, women, and men have discovered that God loves them and walks with them through every season of life.

Historic Santa Claus Campground stands today because generations of faithful believers gave generously and sacrificially so that others might know Jesus too. Now, it's our turn to fan the flame for the next generation of Christ-followers.

As we remain faithful to Christ, God continues to sustain and call us forward. This is a season of renewal and restoration—an opportunity to honor the past while preparing for a vibrant future of ministry.







In 1847, four families joined their farms to create something far greater than land. They gave a place where God could move. From that act of faith, the Santa Claus German Methodist Episcopal Church was born, and with it, the beginnings of this holy ground.

In 1851, wagons lined the roads as more than a thousand people gathered for the first camp meeting—hungry for worship and renewal. By 1884, the Tabernacle rose from the trees cut onsite, standing as both a shelter and a symbol of God's presence. For 141 years, it has welcomed voices lifted in praise, heads bowed in prayer, and lives changed forever.

From the beginning, this place has never been about buildings. It's been about God's Kingdom—built through faith, generosity, and the power of gathering in His name. For generations, lives have been changed here through fellowship, fun, and the transforming presence of Christ.



The spaces that hold sacred moments are showing their age. The Tabernacle—the heartbeat of the camp—needs care to continue welcoming worshipers into the presence of God for the next hundred years. The dining hall strains to serve the growing number of campers who gather to share meals, laughter, and faith. Cabins built long ago no longer provide the safety or comfort today's children and families deserve. Even the lakeside, once alive with joy and reflection, needs renewal to fully serve the next generation.

If this critical work is delayed, the strain on aging spaces will only grow.

- The Tabernacle will continue to need repair.
- The dining hall will struggle to meet demand.
- Outdated cabins will limit how the number of people we impact.

The camp will keep serving faithfully, but each year more time and resources will be spent on maintenance instead of ministry.

This is why now matters. These improvements are not simply about buildings—they are about renewing the spaces where people meet Christ, where faith deepens, and where lives are transformed for God's Kingdom.

By caring for these sacred places today, we ensure that generations to come will continue to encounter Christ, grow in faith, and live out their calling for God's Kingdom.



Now, through a potential partnership with the Lilly Endowment, The Campground has an extraordinary opportunity before it. The Endowment has invited us to apply for a matching grant designed to help Indiana camps strengthen their facilities and expand their impact.

If selected, this partnership could **match local support dollar-for-dollar-half the total cost.** Through this opportunity, a **\$7.18 million vision** could be achieved by raising just **\$3.59 million** from generous friends and partners of the camp. While the outcome is still to be determined, this moment offers a rare chance to strengthen the campground's ministry for the next century and prepare for future growth.

Dining Hall

A new dining hall will nearly double our seating capacity with a 6,000-square-foot gathering space designed for meals, worship, and community connection. It will also create new multipurpose space to be used to meet the needs of camps and groups.



Tabernacle Restoration

For more than 140 years, the Tabernacle has stood as a symbol of faith and fellowship. Restoring its flooring, beams, and adding a protective canvas will **preserve its beauty and safety**, ensuring this sacred space continues to inspire worship and community for decades to come.



Lakeside Pavillion

A new lakeside pavilion will open new opportunities for recreation, gatherings, and fun. Complete with restrooms, concessions, shade, and picnic areas, it will enable full, family-friendly use of the restored lake.




New Cabins & Renovations

Expanding from 280 to 350 beds will increase capacity to invite more people to experience fellowship, faith and fun at the campground and encounter Jesus. New cabins will strengthen supervision and safety, enhance year-round retreat use, and include a dedicated kitchen—making the camp more welcoming and mission-ready than ever before.



Mature Shade Trees

Many of the camp's trees are aging. Planting mature shade trees will renew the natural canopy and preserve the beauty of the grounds for generations to come.



Playground, Soundgarden, & Sports Courts

From inclusive play and music experiences to courts for basketball, pickleball, and more—these **new recreation areas will bring new adventures** for people of all ages.
